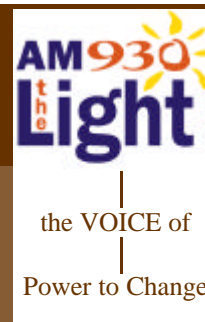

Follow up Strategies that Work

As the harvest comes in follow up becomes a key issue. Many churches already have effective follow up strategies in place such as Alpha groups. We want to encourage you to continue and trust that you will see eternal benefits come from these. For churches who do not already have something in place, or for churches who are looking for another strategy to use along side the ones already in use, we are suggesting the Knowing Jesus Personally magazine and video.

It is a four session course with the topics: Understanding Your Relationship with Jesus Christ, Experiencing God's Love, Power for Living, and Growing in Your Relationship with Christ. There is a 15 minute video portion with speaker Bob Horner each week and then an accompanying study. The Knowing Jesus Personally magazines are \$1.00 ea and the video is \$12.00ea. Each participant will require a magazine but you will need only one video per class.
