Momentum is Building

The campaign is off to a great start! From the Youth Rally on September 20th, attended by 800 people, to the Edmonton Kick Off Rally on September 30th people are hearing about the campaign and are getting excited about what God has planned for us. All of the regions are getting involved and catching the vision for their community. Fort McMurray had a Power to Change Rally with 200 participants! Dawson Creek is taking its trainers to nearby communities to train and encourage the churches there. Churches are holding numerous trainings; training people in Sunday School classes,

in place of Sunday worship services, in small groups, and various other venues.

The heart of the Power to Change Campaign is to equip the church to share the gospel with the people it encounters. Over 275 trainers have been trained to go back to their churches and cities to train others how to share their faith. In our first three evangelism training sessions 700 people were trained. There are over 80 Regional Training sessions planned for this month and many more already going on in individual churches. God is raising up his

Churches can pray for the residents by name, have small groups initiate servant evangelism outreaches, deliver door hangers to the homes, go door-to-door handing out the CD ROM packages, invite residents to special events, or reach out to

them through ministries already established in the church.
