Power to Change is an intensive five-week media campaign during which your community will be saturated with one message—in Jesus, there is Power to Change. The need is real. Fifty-two percent of Canadians surveyed say that they have spiritual needs. Ninety percent of Canadians say they find themselves asking, “what is the meaning of life.”

Over 400 Churches have attended our Regional Church Strategy Meetings in June or September. 95% of all those who attended have indicated their intent to get involved in the P2C Campaign! Many of you are already asking for training materials for your congregations, and are looking at integrating P2C with other outreach projects in your churches. We are excited and overwhelmed by your enthusiasm and your hearts to reach out to your communities.

“At Circle Drive Alliance Church, we see Power to Change as an incredible outreach campaign. Our outreach strategy is built around relational evangelism. Power to Change fits this strategy perfectly. Every person in our congregation is continually challenged to build authentic friendships, to enter into authentic dialogue, and to allow the Holy Spirit to lead their friend to an authentic response. Power to Change will raise the spiritual awareness of each of our contacts, and it provides our people with a powerful tool for sharing their faith and following up on decisions that are made.

Since Power to Change fits our strategy so well at Circle Drive Alliance Church, we have not changed things much. We have just built Power to Change into all of our existing programs. Our prayer teams have been praying for Power to Change since spring. Our Sunday services will be “Power” focused. Rather than taking a “geographic area” to blitz, our people will “blitz” their own circle of contacts. We are also building a follow up team to respond to the calls that are forwarded to us.
