October 10 marked the beginning of a critical part of the P2C campaign as training sessions began across the province. We anticipate that 6,000 people will go through the training over the next 5 weeks.

The 2.5 hour training offers an overview of the campaign, how to share your faith using the information offered and how individuals and churches can be involved in the four suggested strategies during the P2C campaign Oct. 30—December 3. The Training Workshop costs \$10.00 and each participant receives a P2C booklet/CD and a training manual.

**It is simple:** your part is to motivate those in your congregation to attend - our part is to motivate and equip them. New training locations and dates are being added daily - **check [www.share.powertochange.com](http://www.share.powertochange.com) for an up to the minute update.**

The Power to Change booklet contains testimonies, an article about Christ, the Gospel presentation, four follow-up lessons and the Gospel of John. A training manual provides a complete note taking outline for those attending. A strong emphasis is made on the importance of identifying and praying for those within our spheres of influence prior to the campaign and then trusting God to work in their hearts and provide opportunity for open discussion. Thanks to those pastors and churches who have opened their doors to host these events. Let us continue to trust God for changed lives as He works in our province!
