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As the campaign has progressed through the first week the number of incoming calls is increasing steadily. Here are some of the stories:

“One of the first calls came from a man that was responding to the ads on T.V. He said that he was not a Christian but his wife was. He then broke down in tears as he shared that his wife had been praying for him for years.

Nov. 6 at 1:30 p.m. we heard a story from a man who called in. He went to a Power to Change event last night and picked up a booklet and CD. He teaches at a school, so he took the booklet and CD to school today and in showing his class how to use the Internet, he used the Power to Change site, CD and Booklet. After the class, a girl came up to him, and wanted to accept Jesus into her heart.

Another story of a man who was backslidden and hasn't been to church in years. He called looking for something more in his life. The telephone volunteer was able to go through the 4 laws with him and assure him that God was desiring a restored relationship with him. The prayed together and then rejoiced that God's love is unending.

Last night at midnight, just before the call centre closed for the evening, a call came in with a man interested in what Power to Change was about. The phone volunteer got the admin details and then asked if he was interested in spiritual things. He said his desire was to pray and have a personal relationship with Jesus. His life is a mess, but he is now looking to God for the power to change.”
